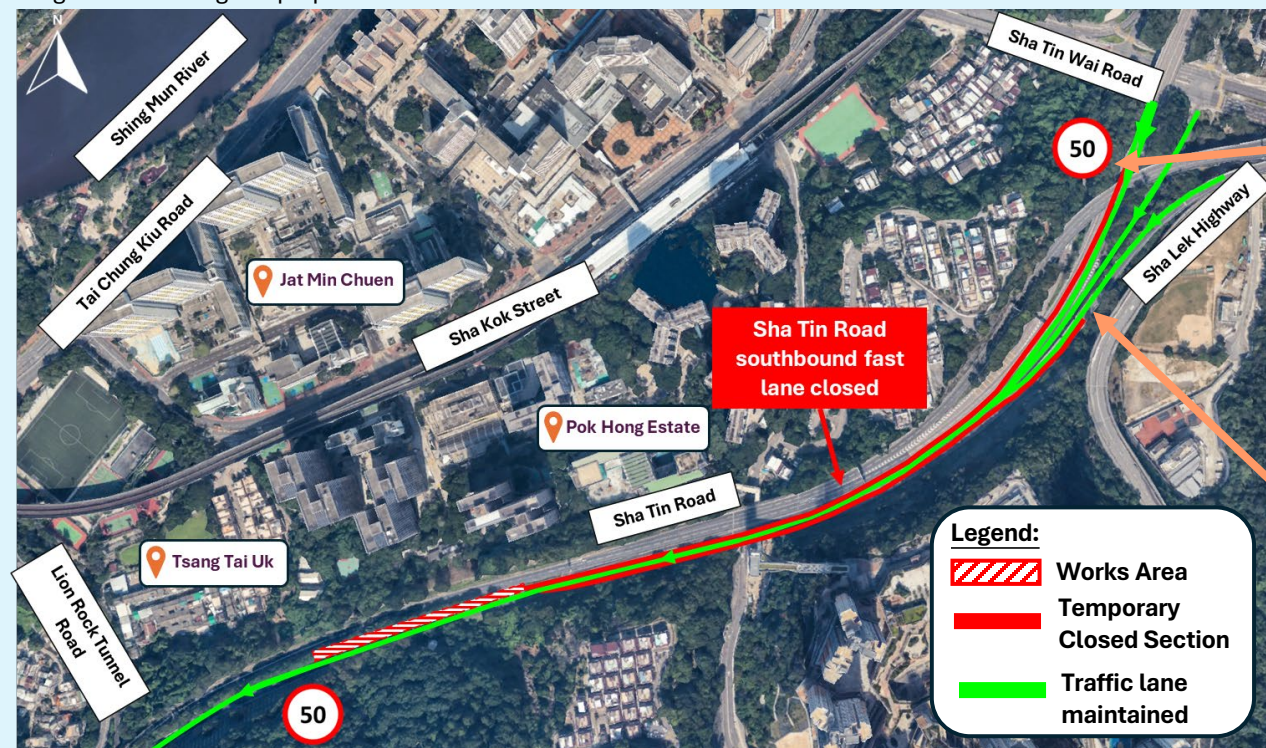


Temporary Closure of part of Sha Tin Road Southbound Fast Lane

Implementation Time : 26th December 2025 (Fri) 07:00 am to 28th December 2025 (Sun) 22:00 pm

- To facilitate the construction of the Sha Tin Trunk Road T4, a section of the fast lane of Sha Tin Road southbound will be temporarily closed for the removal of existing road facilities. Originally, this work was scheduled to be carried out at weekdays from 9:00 p.m. to 11:00 p.m. for over two months, in compliance with the conditions of Construction Noise Permit. In view of the potential noise disturbance and traffic impact, however, the project team proposed completing the works during the upcoming Christmas holidays when traffic flow is lower and with less urgency. The contractor will deploy additional resources and equipment to complete the works within this period.
- While the southbound fast lane will be closed (indicated in red in the figure) during the works, vehicles may continue to use the slow lane to go through the Sha Tin Road Southbound section.
- The speed limit will be temporarily reduced from 80 km/h to 50 km/h to ensure the safety of road users and workers throughout.
- Motorists heading to Kowloon (Central) and Tai Wai are advised to use alternative routes. Variable message signs along Tolo Highway will provide real-time traffic updates to facilitate motorists in adjusting their routes.

- Appropriate traffic signs will be installed at the relevant locations to alert and assist motorists.
- Breaking works will be restricted to 10:00 to 22:00, with mitigation measures such as mobile noise barriers installed to reduce disturbance. From 22:00 to 10:00, only general cleaning and preparation works will be conducted.
